On 7 February 2019, the Council resolved to hold a non-statutory public inquiry, to further consider the Application.

The Inspector appointed to chair the Inquiry, Mr Douglas Edwards QC, has decided to hold a Pre-Inquiry Meeting ("PIM") to discuss procedure for the public inquiry.

Members of the public may attend the PIM. However, non-attendance at the PIM will in no way preclude attendance and participation at the public inquiry in due course. The PIM will be held **on 30 May 2019 at Saltash Town Hall (Council Chamber), 12 Lower Fore St, Saltash PL12 6JX ("Town Hall") and will begin at 11am.**

This meeting is a preliminary meeting to set out how the Inquiry will be conducted. You are therefore not required to attend the above unless you wish to do so. You will be notified of the dates for the Inquiry once it has been set.

Town Hall requirements

Additionally, we wish to draw your attention at this early stage to the conditions of use for the Town Hall, a copy of which is enclosed. In particular, please note that:

1. Any electrical equipment you wish to bring on to the site must have a current PAT Test Certificate or label. This will be of particular importance should you require access to a laptop and/or mobile phone chargers during the course of the PIM and the Inquiry;
