3. MATTERS ARISING.

a) Saltash Community Flood Forum (SCFF) ... As reported last month, SCFF will respond to the Cornwall Site Allocation Development Plan Document (DPD). SCFF will meet again on 24th July (delayed from 26th June) at 6.30pm in the Guildhall where there are to be presentations by Martyn Alvey (Community Flood Resistance Manager from Cornwall County Flood Forum) and Dr Rebecca Pearce (on the benefits of Beaver introduction on the upper reaches of the Tamar).

b) Defibrillator ... Tony to arrange for Jack Felan to come and tell us how the defibrillator works at the 21st August meeting. Tony is to check if Jack needs a screen for his presentation and if he will bring a defibrillator to demonstrate.
