Minutes of FCCA Meeting- Monday 18th June 2018.

2. MINUTES of the May meeting were approved.

3. MATTERS ARISING.

- GDPR. FCCA is compliant and will remain so although work continues.
- Slipway repair. David Salt will arrange delivery of hardcore/chippings to await a working party.
- Hut repair and decoration. Joe reported that the decorator is planning a start date.

4. FORDER EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLAN. David Yates is preparing a Saltash Emergency Response Plan and has found that holding data about vulnerable people may conflict with GDPR. David, Tony and Roger will discuss further. The meeting again questioned whether a separate, defined Forder Plan was a practical proposition due to the administration and insurance involved.

5. CIO STATUS. The first application is to go off to the Charity Commission by the end of June. Tony reported that there will be no fees to pay at this stage.
