FCCA Meeting Minutes 10th June 2019

3. **Minutes of the May meeting** – Jenny Pilgrim was missed from the attendance list. Correction made and all agreed that they were correct. Signed by Carole.
4. **Matters Arising** – None.
5. **Filling vacant committee spaces** – Roger Fuzier volunteered to be membership secretary. A Treasurer still needs to be found.
6. **GDPR** – Statement on data handling has been sent out. Three people have asked to be removed from the contact list.

7. **CIO update** – No news. Bryan Baker asked that this item be taken off the list. Roger Fursier suggested there are outstanding actions for the Solicitor to complete as there are outstanding transfers from the old charity to the new that have yet to go ahead. The old charity cannot be closed until all of the assets are transferred. Financial transfers have taken place, but lease transfers are yet to be completed. It was agreed that this item would move from monthly meeting to committee meeting.

10. **Moorings Officer’s Report** – Slipway has been re-built but another section has collapsed in front of the hall. The work is outstanding. Keel from Pikey’s boat has been used to bolster the East bank. A roster of willing grass mowers is needed or perhaps Mr Carter can cut the grass in the orchard? A quote has been requested. Most mooring fees are in but a **reminder to non-payers to please send fees as soon as possible.**
11. **Neighbourhood Watch** – nothing to report
12. **Planning Issues** – Crannog House planning application has been refused on the grounds that the division between Saltash and Forder would be eroded. The application did not go to the Cornwall Council planning committee. The Forder objection raised at Saltash Town Council formed a substantial portion of their reason for recommending refusal. The reason for refusal was the same reason given by the planning inspector on appeal. The neighbourhood plan shows the boundaries clearly and this will make it clearer in future that it is an area not to be built on. The proposed orchard is still on offer to the Council for £1 on Facebook.

13. **CIC news** – Saltash Regatta, the Hopper Bus will be offering a free shuttle service down to Brunel Green. (see timetable attached). The CIC item will be removed from the agenda in future.
